### E-MOBILITY: ENEL X WAY BRINGS MOBILE CHARGING TO SKI RESORTS IN PARTNERSHIP WITH E-GAP

- *In Canazei and Madonna di Campiglio, Enel X Way will offer mobile recharging on demand for electric vehicles thanks to the service provided by E-GAP vans, totally innovative and equipped with a system for fast recharging, which can be booked through the Enel X Way app;*
- *The initiative is part of a broader partnership that also includes the possibility for Enel X Way customers to receive a €30 voucher that will entitle them to mobile recharging of their electric cars in the five Italian cities (Milan, Rome, Bologna, Turin, Brescia) where the E-GAP service is present.*

**Rome, 3 February 2023** - Planning a trip to the mountains with an electric car becomes even easier: in Canazei, until 7 February, and in Madonna di Campiglio, from 8 to 28 February, it will be possible to take advantage of an innovative service thanks to the collaboration between Enel X Way, Enel's company dedicated to electric mobility, and E-GAP, the first urban, mobile and on-demand fast charging service in Europe.

On those days in the ski resorts those driving an electric vehicle will be able to book fast and on-demand recharging through the Enel X Way app and an E-GAP van will reach the vehicle, even in the absence of the owner. The initiative is part of a broader partnership that also envisages, among other things, the possibility for Enel X Way customers to receive a €30 voucher that will entitle them to mobile recharging of their electric cars in the five Italian cities (Milan, Rome, Bologna, Turin, Brescia) where the E-GAP service is present.

*"Today we are implementing our partnership with E-GAP, enriching the recharging experience of our customers who, in order to fill up with energy, will be able to rely on the network of recharging points present throughout the country and on the on-demand service," said **Riccardo Amoroso**, Head of Marketing and Sales Enel X Way. "After this summer's success in Liguria and Tuscany, we have chosen two of the most important ski destinations in the country, Canazei and Madonna di Campiglio, to replicate the initiative by offering electric drivers the possibility of booking E-GAP vans directly on the new Enel X Way app to take advantage of a quick recharge in just a few minutes at the place where their car is".*

*"After the success of last August's partnership at Argentario and Santa Margherita Ligure, we have decided to further consolidate our agreement with Enel X Way by making our mobile recharging service available also to customers in two of Italy's most popular ski destinations," comments **Luca Fontanelli**, Europe General Manager and Italy CEO of E-GAP. "In a very complex phase for the automotive sector, we are convinced that the transition to electric mobility is now a matter of the present and no longer of the future, and we therefore believe that cooperation between operators in the sector is increasingly important to guarantee those who have chosen to use an electric car the maximum convenience of recharging and to*



*incentivise those who still have qualms about choosing the transition to sustainable mobility," concluded Fontanelli.*

There are over 18,000 recharging points that Enel X Way has set up in Italy, making it the largest nationwide recharging network available to electric drivers. The recharging power of the E-GAP van is equal to that of a fast-type column, up to 80kW, and will soon reach 100kW. In the past year, E-GAP has also developed its presence in Europe: France, Spain and Germany in the main cities, with an expansion of its fleet of on-demand electric recharging vehicles that has reached 100 new e-vans in the past few months, with the goal of reaching 500 vans by next year.

**Enel X Way** is the Enel Group company entirely dedicated to electric mobility. With about 430 thousand charging points, Enel X Way operates in 16 countries, directly, through joint ventures such as Ewiva in Italy, and through various interoperability agreements worldwide. As a global platform for e-mobility, the company is focused on developing flexible electric vehicle charging technologies and solutions to improve the customer experience by supporting the electrification of transport for consumers, businesses, cities and public administrations.

**E-GAP** is the first urban, mobile and on-demand fast charging service. Via the smartphone app of the same name, E-GAP makes it possible to receive a home, 'fast charge' recharge via zero-emission e-van. Active in Milan, Rome, Bologna, Turin, Brescia and present in Paris, Madrid and Munich, it will soon be available in other Italian and European cities. E-GAP was founded by Chairman and major shareholder Eugenio de Blasio, one of the pioneers of the Green Economy sector, former CEO and top manager of Nasdaq-listed groups, and Global CEO Daniele Camponeschi, Chief Investment Officer in leading financial groups. The company also employs top managers with significant multidisciplinary experience at international level such as Luca Fontanelli, Europe General Manager and Italy CEO.
